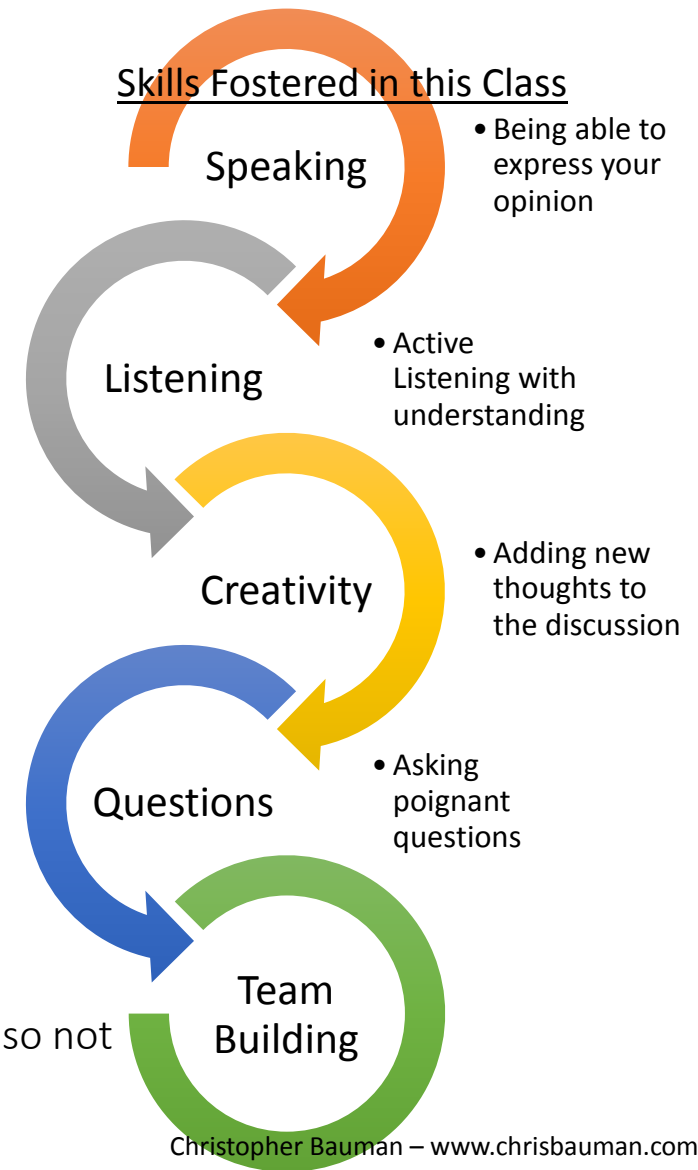
Meet people where they are, and not where we think they should be
